- They also suggested that there be a personal hygiene class, that the flight staff meet with SET about how to set up the barracks, the cadets with the most 341's for the day will have C.Q., if a cadet gets nine 341's they need to have a meeting with the Cadet Encampment Commander.

- Other suggestions included but were not limited to: having more hands on activities, learning more about communication and using radios, building junk rockets, team leadership games, visiting the control tower, the C-130 mechanic shop, and the fire depot.
