**Wing Finance Committee Meeting**

19 June 2006

The meeting was called to order by the Finance Committee Chairman, Col Joseph Jensen. In attendance Col Joseph Jensen, Lt Col Herb Williams, Caption Henry Lile, Lt Col Robert Betzold, Lt Col Robert Penton, Susan Brewczynski, Captain Joel Buckner, Lt Col John Pauly, and Major Bobby Allison.

Col Joseph Jensen established a quorum was present.

Col Joseph Jensen established the quarterly finance audit had been done by Lt Col Robert Penton had been done and was in order.

Col Jensen explained there was approximately \$21,000 extra dollars in the training budget and asked for a group to get together to establish a budget for flying.

Col Jensen announced that three of the older 172's will go to the National Flight Academy in Oklahoma 21 July 2006. Lt Col John Pauly, Lt Col Tom Eastman and Major Bruce Baily will be taking them.

Lt Col Herb Williams announced he was working on getting approval for a Bird Tracking Mission in Dewitt.

Lt Col. Penton stated that there was roughly about \$18,900 in the CAP account. He stated the there was about \$71,800 in expenditures with the majority of expenses coming from the vehicle maintenance and repairs.

Captain Buckner volunteered to due an aircraft spreadsheet for three months to track all aircrafts expenses before handing the spreadsheets over to Chabli.

Col Jensen gave the quarterly Wing Financial Report. Copies of the Balance Sheet, P & L, and State Spreadsheet were given to each member.

Lt Col Williams stated the wing conference was a big success and no money was lost and \$100.00 was made in profit.

Col Jensen reported that the state appropriates \$40,000 a year to CAP and \$9,000.00 was received from member dues.

Major Lile checked the report for finances. Lt Col Robert Penton agreed to the checking of the next report of finances and agreed to the joining the finance committee.

Col Jensen suggests the wing credit card will be issued the name of Chabli instead of Susan due to a conflict of interest stated in the regulations. The regulation states that a member cannot have a credit card issued in their name as a corporate employee. The committee agreed.

Lt Col Nortier requested \$500.00 to be included in the budget for the Chaplin training fund. Col Jensen stated that a private donor, who would like to remain anonymous, would donate \$250.00 for this cause. The committee agreed.

Col Jensen moved to adjourn. Lt Col Williams seconded. Meeting was adjourned at 1815 hours.
